- Butterfly Herbs – an eclectic assortment of jewelry, body products, tea, coffee, candies and more.
- Soul City Dry Goods – fun shop to poke around, with lots of Montana- themed goods and cheeky gifts
- Tosca Fine Olive Oils & Balsamics – unique, locally-crafted oils, vinegars and more.
- Rockin Rudy's - literally everything you don't need in one building!

Hangout Spots:

- The ZACC - art, paint-your-own-pottery, music, and more!
- The Florence Building – historic landmark with a coffee shop
- Carousel – a hand-painted Missoula classic. Fun rides for all ages.

Bars & Distilleries

- Montgomery Distillery – Handcrafted cocktails made with their own whiskey, gin or vodka
- Plonk – great cocktail bar open late
- Rhino – a “classy dive bar” open very late
